Cleveland, Ohio, USA – July 10, 2013 - - Based on the success of the introductory sessions over the past 12 months, ISCEA announced today the expansion of their Certified Lean Six Sigma Yellow Belt (CLSSYB) certification program to the global market. It is important that individuals know how to support these efforts to the benefit of their organizations, and their careers.” stated Dr. Eric Jones of University Texas. The CLSSYB program is Globally Accredited by IISB and offered locally by ISCEA.
